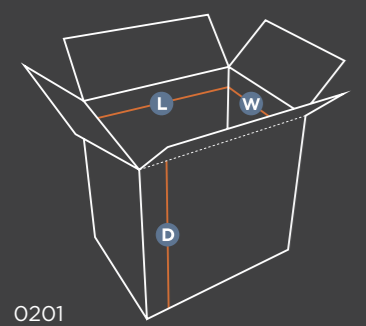

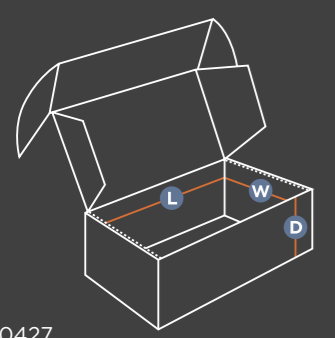
1 Box style

2 Box size

Determine the size of your box by measuring the length, width and depth of your product. Box dimensions are measured internally to ensure they fit your product correctly.



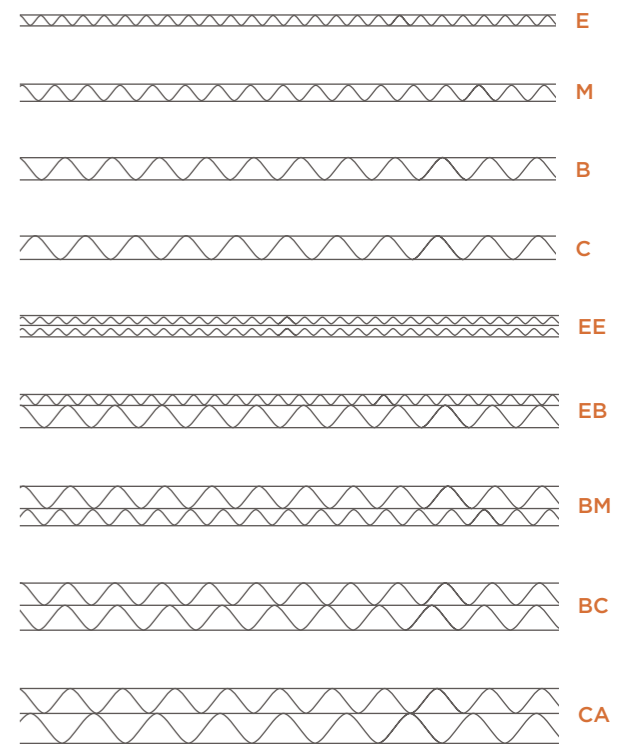
3 Material

The performance of your bespoke box is dependent on the paper liner and fluting which both can be varied in terms of grammage and recycled content. Consider new, lighter weight flutes which use less material without forfeiting strength and are great to print on.

The outer liner is often 'Kraft', a strong, less porous, moisture resistant paper, whereas the inner liner can be "Test" which contains a high percentage of recycled content.

CHOICE OF PRINT FINISHES

Choosing the print process is not easy. There are so many factors to consider; brand fit, printing surface, quantity required, product life cycle, budget. We can help you choose the right print for your product.



FLEXOGRAPHIC PRINTING

This printing process is the most common for corrugated packaging and uses a flexible rubber or polymer relief plate (stereo) for each ink colour. It is a cost effective but good standard of print and ideal for corrugated printing and continuous designs.



LITHOGRAPHIC PRINTING

Suitable for high-end, magazine quality reproduction of images. This is a high quality and consistent printing method whereby an image, from a metal plate is transferred onto a rubber blanket and the image transferred onto the material by applying pressure.



DIGITAL PRINTING

In digital printing, an image is sent directly to the printer using a digital file, with CMYK colour process print. This is suitable for multicolour designs and images. The ink is applied directly onto the surface, removing the need for a printing plate.
